1. To review the progress of the implementation of the academic policies formulated by the KVS(HQ) at the regional level.
2. To monitor academic innovations/experiments in KVs To oversee the facilities such as library, laboratory, audio-visual aids etc. in Vidyalayas of the region.
3. To review the progress of games and sports activities in Kendriya Vidyalayas in the region.
4. To review the progress of cultural activities in Kendriya Vidyalayas in the region.
5. To suggest suitable locations for opening new Kendriya Vidyalayas in the region.
6. To build and protect the image of Kendriya Vidyalayas in the region.

Minutes of the Regional Sports Control Board Meeting

Minutes of the Regional Sports Control Board Meeting held on 13.03.2018 at 10.00 A.M. in the office of the Deputy Commissioner, KVS (RO) Varanasi.

In compliance with the instructions issued through this office letter No. 43358/KVS/RO/VNS/2018-19/1033 dated 06/03/2018, a meeting of the members of the Regional Sports Control Board with special invitees was held as per notified schedule to deliberate upon various agenda items communicated through letter under reference.

Agenda Items:

1. **Ratification of the minutes of the previous meeting of the RSCB.**
The minutes of the RSCB meeting held on 06.04.2017 were read out before the members and these were ratified unanimously. The general body meeting of the RSCB was held on 02-03 July, 2017 during Regional Principals' Conference. The resolutions of which were circulated with the minutes of the Regional Principals' Conference.
2. **Income and Expenditure details of the RSCB fund in 2017-18.**
The Finance Officer cum treasurer of the RSCB presented the annual income & expenditure account of the RSCB fund which was ratified by the members present in the meeting.
3. **Assessment of Regional and National level Games and Sports Events conducted in 2017-18.** The members observed that as compared to the year 2016-17, the performance of Boys as well as Girls (overall) has increased due to intensive efforts made at various levels. Boys U-19, Volleyball got Silver medal. Boys U-14 Volleyball – Gold Medal, U-19 Basketball – Silver Medal, Girls U-14 Kabaddi – Gold Medal, Rope Skipping Team event – Gold, Boxing U14 Boys – 2nd Place overall, Athletics – 09 Gold, 05 Silver & 02 Bronze medal, Taekwondo – 4 Silver & 1 Bronze medal. However, it was felt that there is further scope for improvement in performance of participants especially of girls at National level.
4. **Venues and date for conduct of Regional Sports Meet for 2018-19:** may be decided now on the basis of infrastructure, accessibility and geographical location. It was decided that the Regional Sports Meet 2017-18 be completed in April itself from 12-14 April 2018 (Football U-14 & U17), 16-20 April, 2018 (Cricket U17&U19) and 16-18 April, 2018 for other games.
5. **The action plan for smooth conduct of Regional and National level Games and Sports Events in the Academic session 2017-18.**
 - (i) As per the direction of the KVS Headquarters, the Regional Sports venue Principals will ensure participation of children at National venue with confirmed reservation for onward and return journey.
 - (ii) This year's National Sports Meet venues will be communicated at a later date.
 - (iii) In order to reduce unwanted duplicity in paper work, the board members resolved to collect only one set of consolidated details of team (proforma will be sent) at initial level for participation at Regional venue. Fresh set of eligibility certificates in quadruplicate of qualified participants may be collected at the time of their reporting for Pre-National Coaching cum selection camp. The eligibility certificate should be as per SGFI norms.
 - (iv) After evaluating previous year's performance and movement schedule, it has been resolved to retain TGT (P&HE) of Regional venue in their respective KV. However TGT (P&HE) who are posted in KVs where Regional events are not being held will preferably be deputed to the venue of their area of expertise.
 - (v) A Regional level selection committee will be notified later.
 - (vi) It has also been resolved to strictly adhere to the guidelines and instructions issued by KVS National Sports Control Board from time to time.

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- (vii) The procurement procedure of Sports Kit for Regional and National meet was elaborately discussed and the following decisions have been made:-
- To adopt the process of open tender through News paper advertisement.
 - Due to paucity of staff in Regional Office, Principal of KV Mughalsarai to be authorized to complete the process of tender advertisement and up to preparation of comparative statement. A committee constituted by the Deputy Commissioner, KVS, RO Varanasi will assist him.
 - The tender document has also been approved by the committee.
 - Finalization / selection of Kit / Material will be done by the purchase committee consisting of following members:-

Due to convenience the display of the materials may be done at KV BHU Varanasi on a date finalized by the DC, KVS, RO, Varanasi.

- The topic of best quality teams participation in Nationals was deliberated in detail. In order to ensure quality teams, participating in Nationals, it is decided to send teams which have been in the first 6 in the last meet as well as selection of teams should be done on the basis of winnability and securing positions at least within the top six.
- (viii) Observers at Regional venues may be deputed on requirement basis.
- The members resolved to continue with the practice of conducting pre-National coaching cum selection camp for duration of 7-10 Days, twice, once during Summer vacation and then before National Sports Meet. (These coaching cum selection camp will be organized for only specific games).
However the KVS (HQ) instructions if any otherwise the duration of the camp may be finally decided in consultation with the Principals during the conference.
 - While selecting students for individual games, care has to be taken that they conform with the benchmarks circulated by KVS.
 - No. of students per team will be as per new norms attached.
6. Steps to be taken for improvement in performance in Sports:
- Identification of games for improvement in performance in NSM, 2018-19 is to be followed in all KVs (Venue as well as participating KVs). Academic loss compensation programme is to be followed in all KVs.
 - It is recommended to increase the participation of girls at various levels with special focus on games like, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Rope Skipping, Handball, Athletics and Volley Ball.
 - The performance of the Region has been reasonably good in Basketball, Athletics, Kabaddi, Volleyball and Cricket. Schools should ensure that our teams do well in these games in the next NSM also.

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- (iv) Preparation for participation in National Sports Meet, 2019-20 and 2020-21 should start from now itself in terms of identification and training of students and development of infrastructure.
- (v) The following infrastructure should be developed in all schools subject to availability of space utilizing their own funds following laid down procedure – Equipment of parallel bars, jungle gym for physical training, Jumping pits and running track, kabaddi and Kho-Kho grounds.
- (vi) Regular / contractual Yoga teachers should train students in large numbers and display of Yoga exercises comprising of 100-120 children should be done. Students should be trained in formation and display of gymnastic formations like pyramids. Team sent for Yoga should be trained properly.
- (vii) Teacher or TGT (P&HE) deputed as escorts of the Regional Sports Contingents for the NSM should be discouraged from seeking exemptions at the last moment. A written comment be taken from lady teachers before deputing them for escorting duty. Normally, the teachers deputed to escort the teams will not be granted exemption.
- (viii) After intensive deliberation, the members of the RSCB resolved that all teachers (irrespective of cadre) deputed to escort the teams at National Level will be provided a complete set of sports kit as per the guidelines of the NSCB.
- (ix) It is observed that the services of coaches / experts engaged by the schools in various disciplines are not utilized effectively. Principals are advised to evolve a mechanism to ensure optimum utilization of the services of these coaches in the school.
- (x) Teams should be prepared and trained well by arranging friendly matches with local teams available on the station.
- (xi) Coaching camps can be conducted by schools in a phased manner.
- (xii) The following schools will prepare teams for participation in NSM 2018-19 in the following games (apart from other games) - Pole vault (2017) – KV BHU Varanasi, DLW Varanasi and Mughalsarai. 400 Mtr. Hurdles (2017) – KV FCI Gorakhpur, Mughalsarai, DLW and BHU Varanasi. At least two students from these schools should be trained for Nationals this year.
- (xiii) At least one student from every KV should be trained for long distance running and other such games where infrastructure requirements are minimal.
- (xiv) Focus should be on identification and training of students at an early age and efforts should be made to prepare teams for participation in games at U-14 level.
- (xv) It is to be ensured that students are trained in marching.
- (xvi) Students who are currently appearing in / appeared in class X can also participate in the Regional Sports Meet, 2018. Selection list in respect of these students will be provisional subject to revision on the admission in a KV of the Region. Students who are admitted on sports certificate may also be allowed to participate in coaching cum selection camp (if held in that particular game).

7. Funds for development of Sports Infrastructure in Kendriya Vidyalayas : + previous balance is 44 lakhs.

- (i) The total annual expected income of RSCB is 60 lakhs expected expenditure on
 - a. Journey for NSM and SGFI - 30 lakhs
 - b. Provision of Kit and equipment - 30 lakhs
 - c. Coaching cum selection camp for NSM - 30 lakhs

Which will leave approximately 14 lakhs in the fund for contingencies. It is proposed that since the Region is a small one with very little collection from schools, the following only will be paid for from RSCB fund:-

- 1. Expenditure for payment of honorarium to officials during RSM.
- 2. T.A. / D.A. expenditure towards teams participating in NSM.
- 3. Playing Kit and equipment for participation in NSM.
- 4. Expenditure incurred during coaching camp cum selection camp for NSM.

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- (ii) All expenditure towards T.A. / D.A. and other expenditure of students participating in RSM is to be done by the participating KVs from their own VVN.
- (iii) Organising venue KVs will be paid only honorarium of officials after completion of RSM (on production of receipt) from RSCB fund.
8. Recognition to Schools and TGT (P&HE) / Teachers for Outstanding performance in National Sports Meet and SGFI:-
 Committee proposed that schools and teachers should be recognised and motivated for best performance in NSMs, SGFI during the Regional Incentive Awards Ceremony.
 Any school that gets:-
 1 Team, Gold in NSM.
 2 At least 30 or more points in aggregate.
 3 Selection in KVS for Subroto Cup / Nehru Cup.
- (a) In case of team games (U-17 / U-19) Team Gold – TGT (P&HE) who trained the team will be recognised and appreciated in the Regional Award Ceremony.
- (b) In case of U-14 Team Gold, Principal and teacher concerned will be appreciated during Regional Award Ceremony.
9. The committee felt that where performance of students of the Region has not improved in last few years and where students have not shown any interest in improving their performance, Region can consider not sending of entries at National level, however participation at Regional level can be allowed.
 In case of games like Lawn Tennis, Badminton, Table Tennis, Chess, Skating etc. participation at National level will be considered only if individual students have shown any promising achievements at state or National level in open competitions.
 For participation in RSM, in all games, TGT (P&HE) and Principal to ensure that team / individuals sent for participation are up to the benchmark. In case it is found that any participant or team is below benchmark / below par disciplinary action will be initiated against the persons responsible.
10. Fitness Test during coaching camp:-
 Proper fitness followed by skill test must be conducted within first three days in selection cum pre-national coaching camp. The students other than the selection list should be sent back to their concerned KVs. The test items are as follows:-
 A. Fitness Test - 1.- 600 mtr. Run / walk, 2. Standing broad jump, 3. Bent knee situps, 4. Modified pull ups, 5. 4x10 mtr. Shuttle run, 6. 50 Mtr. Dash
 B. Skill proficiency as per game.
11. Certificates of RSM, 2018 will be printed and distributed to venue KVs by Principal KV AFS Gorakhpur. The expenditure will be made through VVN of KV AFS Gorakhpur.
12. Food items provided in RSM 2018 and coaching camp must be nutritious and less oily.

The meeting ended on a positive note.
